Community Engagement on the Water Project

In November, 2016, two Open Houses were held at the SPID office. Over 60 residents viewed the plans for the 2017 phase of the construction project that will see the water line replacement for all homes on Ships Point. SPID has created a Project Liaison Team to provide residents with a conduit for their questions and concerns to be fed to the consultancy team leading the project.

The plans remain in the SPID office and residents are encouraged to review them and understand the impact of the construction on their property. A feedback form is available.
