- UBCM Emergency Services 2023 Grant on 'FD training facility & eqpt upgrades'
 - Final Grant payment received from UBCM
- Approached MOTI to provide 'No Beach Fire' signage on the beach access road off Wente Way & on Aboyne Road
 - Advised that no suitable signage in their inventory
 - Seeking to obtain a permit from MOTI to allow installation of our own signage
- AED mounted in the hallway between the SPID office & training room for use in the event of a cardiac collapse in the office
- Construction on the Training Center Sea Containers is approaching completion, use of the facility for dept training has commenced
- FD summer picnic social scheduled for Sat, 24 Aug 24
