New Items for Info/Discussion

- UBCM Emergency Services 2022 Grant on 'FD eqpt & training resources'
 - UBCM has confirmed that they have received the grant final report
 - Still waiting on final cheque payment
- UBCM Emergency Services 2023 Grant on 'FD training facility & eqpt upgrades'
 - Digital ATTACK training equipment has arrived with invoice submitted for payment
 - Fire-rated thermal imaging camera (TIC) on order
 - Final Grant Report will be submitted as soon as TIC is received
- UBCM funding manager has confirmed that Improvement Districts are eligible for FireSmart funding
 - Improvement District cannot directly apply, but Regional District is expected to apply on our behalf
 - As such, the Regional FireSmart coordinator will cover Association chipping weekend up to \$5K expenditure
- SPVFFA chipping weekend scheduled for 04-05 May 24
 - With access to \$5K funding, Association is looking at most effective way to deliver the service
 - IAW Grant criteria, homeowner is not allowed to retain the chips due to fire fuel loading
 - Burn permits will once again be required for all back yard burns effective 15 Apr 2024
- Training has commenced on upgrading all FRs on the EMA increased scope of practice
 - Increased protocols will allow us to better serve the community on an FR callout
 - Red Cross Instructor Certification course completed
 - All equipment required to support update has been purchased/received thanks to Association funding
 - Training to be scheduled
