

SHIPS POINT IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT
BY-LAW No. 106

A bylaw fixing water tolls and other charges payable to the District. The Trustees of Ships Point Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Effective on the first day of January 2020 the following tolls are hereby fixed and made payable by all owners of premises in the District to which water is delivered with the works of the District.

1. Unmetered Water Rates

- a. In respect of each single dwelling for residential use an annual toll of \$ 329.00
 - b. In respect of each single dwelling for short term rental use an annual toll of \$ 429.00
 - c. In respect of each additional dwelling that utilizes a water connection and is located on the same parcel of land as a. or b. above, an annual toll of \$ 294.00.
2. The aforesaid tolls shall be due and payable on or before the first day of March following the billing date, and any tolls remaining unpaid after the said date shall have added thereto a percentage addition of 15% (ten percent) thereof. Ships Point Improvement District may prorate tolls to the nearest month.
3. The improvement district may, on 24 hours written notice, by trustee resolution order the water shut off to any premises that has not paid its water tolls or does not disclose the property changes in its water classification within one month from the time the District becomes aware of the change in water services supplied by Ships Point Improvement District.
4. In addition, to the aforementioned charges, each time the owner or occupier of premises request that the water be turned on or off, or when the water is turned on or off on the order of the trustees there is fixed and made payable to the District a charge of \$ 60.00.
5. This By-law repeals By-law No. 103.
6. This By-law may be cited as the “ 2020 Water Tolls By-law”.
